We, as a Catholic educational organization, are faithful to, and seek to advance, all the religious and moral teachings of the Catholic Church especially as found in the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the official teachings of its Magisterium, which are based on the teachings of Our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

We believe everything contained in God's word, written or handed on in Tradition by the Church - whether in solemn judgment or in the ordinary and universal Magisterium - as divinely revealed and calling for faith.

We believe in the sacredness of life from the moment of conception to natural death, that all persons are created in the image and likeness of God as male or female, and that marriage is between a man and a woman and the only context in which sexual intimacy/the marital embrace is allowed. We believe that the family is ordained by God as the basic unit of His plan for His people.
