KINDERGARTEN students will:

- Create projects and crafts
- Experience God's creation around them through wonder and discovery
- Enjoy snacks, lunch, and recess
- Establish fundamental learning habits in a Catholic & classical environment

KINDERGARTEN RELIGION students will:

- Attend Holy Mass and learn to sit quietly, listen, and pray with other students

KINDERGARTEN MATH students will:

- Count to 50 and write numbers 1-50
- Begin their study of adding and subtracting
- Think about basic math concepts and enhance their understanding of the world around them

KINDERGARTEN SCIENCE students will:

- Observe and study the basic parts of a plant
- Observe and describe seasons and weather
- Learn about their five senses

- Draw, color, and paint
- See great works of art by famous artists
- Observe and experiment with colors
